**FR. NEVILLE RETURNS TO SRI LANKA**



Fr. Neville Jansze could often be seen walking the campus while praying the rosary or sitting on a bench with his prayer book or guitar. His was a peaceful and prayerful presence that will be missed. Fr. Neville was called back to his diocese in Sri Lanka and returned there just after Easter. Before he left he received many well wishes and gifts from grateful parishioners who will miss his kind and joyful spirit. Fr. Neville served as Parochial Vicar at St. Theresa for nearly four years. He said he felt blessed to be assigned to serve the needs of the parish

and minister to the children of the school and parish. “I like to be with kids because I like to teach them the joy of God,” he said. “We can make the world better by showing a good example to kids and just being with them.”

He said his favorite part of his ministry here was hearing Confession. “I like to be at the Confessional to help people, to speak to them about the way God wants them to live,” he said. “Confession is the time we make sinners to come to God's Kingdom, to make them saints.” Fr. Neville will be near family when he returns to his home diocese in Nattandiya, Sri Lanka. He wants to concentrate on the ministry for the poor there by working with the Franciscan Sisters of Mary.

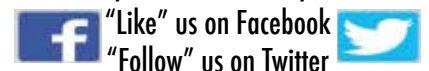
**SUPPER CLUB: ADULT FELLOWSHIP OPPORTUNITY AT ST. THERESA!**

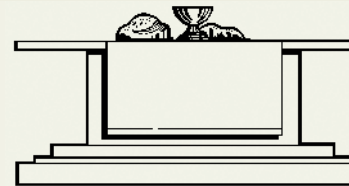

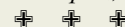
